SET UP THE GAME BOARD (with the help of an adult)

- 2. Cut slits in the game board near letters A, B, and C.
- 3. Cut out the short-cut arches below and fold the ends.
- 4. Slip the folded ends of the short-cut arches into the slits with the
- 1. All players begin on the START square and roll the die (not included)
- 2. Each player takes turns rolling the die and moving the correct
- 3. When a player lands on a MARVELOUS MESS UP square (#3, #7, or #11), they tell everyone about their own miraculous mess up. The player can then take the short cut and move up.
- 4. When a player lands on a MEGA MESS UP square (#6 and #10), they have to return to the START square. That's okay! More time to play!
- 5. The first player to the FINISH square wins!
