

Mendel's Hanukkah MESS UP GAME

Sometimes mess ups can be marvelous. In *Mendel's Hanukkah Mess Up*, Mendel crashes the Mitzvah Mobile. What a big mistake! Or was it? When Mendel tells Rachel, the reporter, about his accident, he ends up letting everybody know the meaning of Hanukkah. His mess up turns into something magical! Have you ever messed up? Did your mess up ever turn into something magnificent?

SET UP THE GAME BOARD (with the help of an adult)

1. Cut out the Mitzvah Mobiles below.
2. Cut slits in the game board near letters A, B, and C.
3. Cut out the short-cut arches below and fold the ends.
4. Slip the folded ends of the short-cut arches into the slits with the matching letters.

GAME PLAY

1. All players begin on the START square and roll the die (not included) to see who goes first.
2. Each player takes turns rolling the die and moving the correct number of spots.
3. When a player lands on a MARVELOUS MESS UP square (#3, #7, or #11), they tell everyone about their own miraculous mess up. The player can then take the short cut and move up.
4. When a player lands on a MEGA MESS UP square (#6 and #10), they have to return to the START square. That's okay! More time to play!
5. The first player to the FINISH square wins!
